From Brussels National Airport:

By train: The city centre is less than 20 minutes from the airport by train. The airport train station is located below the terminal (basement level-1). Every 15 minutes there are trains to Brussels North (Gare du Nord/Noordstation), Brussels Central (Gare Central/Centraal Station) and Brussels South (Gare du Midi/Zuidstation) stations.

To get to our office, you have to get off the train at Brussels Central Station, and take either metro line 1 (direction Stockel) or 5 (direction Herrmann-Debroux). You need to get off at Arts-Loi (only two stops from Central Station). Leave the metro via exit 'Joseph II'. From this exit, which is on Avenue des Arts/Kunstlaan, turn left and take the first left onto Rue de la Loi/Wetstraat. Take the first left onto Rue du Commerce/Handelsstraat. You will find the office at number 124.

By Taxi: Taxis with a taximeter are permanently available in front of the arrivals hall. The fare from the airport to the city centre of Brussels is normally around 35€. Licensed taxis can be recognized by the blue and yellow emblem. Travellers are advised to avoid unlicensed taxis!

From North Station (Gare du Nord/Noordstation):

Take metro line 3 (direction Gare du Midi), get off at De Brouckere, and change either to line 1 (direction Stockel) or 5 (direction Herrmann-Debroux). You need to get off at Arts-Loi. Leave the metro via exit 'Joseph II'. From this exit, which is on Avenue des Arts/Kunstlaan, turn left and take the first left onto Rue de la Loi/Wetstraat. Take the first left onto Rue du Commerce/Handelsstraat. You will find the office at number 124.

From Central Station (Gare Central/Centraal Station):

Take either metro line 1 (direction Stockel) or 5 (direction Herrmann-Debroux). You need to get off at Arts-Loi (only two stops from Central Station). Leave the metro via exit 'Joseph II'. From this exit, which is on Avenue des Arts/Kunstlaan, turn left and take the first left onto Rue de la Loi/Wetstraat. Take the first left onto Rue du Commerce/Handelsstraat. You will find the office at number 124.

From South Station (Gare du Midi/Zuidstation):

Take either metro line 2 or 6 (direction Simonis (Elisabeth)). You need to get off at Arts-Loi. Leave the metro via exit 'Joseph II'. From this exit, which is on Avenue des Arts/Kunstlaan, turn left and take the first left onto Rue de la Loi/Wetstraat. Take the first left onto Rue du Commerce/Handelsstraat. You will find the office at number 124.

From Charleroi Airport:

By bus: Every 30 minutes a shuttle coach leaves the airport to take you to Brussels South Station (Gare du Midi/Zuidstation). Shuttle tickets are sold outside the airport terminal (one way ticket €13, return ticket €22). The duration of the bus ride is 1 hour.
