At an IFOAM EU Group's Board meeting it was decided to develop a first paper that deals with the questions set out below.</p> <p>The work is organised in a poultry expert group. A range of issues were discussed at the November 2010 meeting in Brussels and they will form the basis of the work over the coming months. The aim is to bring a meeting to France in the first quarter of 2011 to discuss a first proposal for positions on these issues.</p> <p>The group is currently open for new poultry experts who would like to join and contribute to the work. Interested persons should contact their national board member.</p> <p>1.1.2 Commission Expert Group for technical advice The expert group for technical advice on organic production, established by the European Commission, convened for the first time on December 15 in Brussels. The first topic on the agenda was for the group to establish itself and to agree on terms of reference and work plans. Detailed documents can be found here.</p> <p>1.1.3 Commission report on the scope of the Organic Regulation requested The Council Regulation (EU) 2010/1848 (the Organic Regulation) will be the cornerstone to support the Council for the year of 2011 on the work of the Regulation. It will be the main instrument for the Commission to go about the marketing. The IFOAM EU Group is happy to work out concrete suggestions and comments on the above.</p> <p>1.1.4 Consultation on organic seaweed rules The IFOAM EU Group has published between December 15, 2010, and January 15, 2011, on the EU organic production and marketing rules included in the Organic Regulation and its implementing rules (Regulation (EU) No 1831/2010 and Regulation (EU) No 1831/2010). The consultation aims to assess the impact of organic, health and other organic products on the welfare of the current EU rules on organic seaweed production and collection.
