



Application Procedure

Once you have agreed the screening procedure. The Application Form should be completed, signed and submitted electronically and by post with your CV and recommendation from a current IFC member.

Background and Guiding Documents

The membership of IFC, is defined in the Rules of Procedure, the Criteria for Membership and the Code of Conduct. All members agree to abide by the terms in these documents.

Application

The application is open to any IFOAM member or supporter. An application can be made at any time. Any IFOAM member who is interested in becoming a member should take note of the following information:

- Rules of Procedures of IFC
 - Criteria for membership of IFC
 - Code of conduct of IFC
 - Membership application form
- The applicant shall submit to the coordinator the following:
- A completed membership application form, signed to indicate agreement and acceptance of the IFC Rules of Procedure, Criteria for Membership and Code of Conduct. E-mail and signed hard copy.
 - A CV (Word file)
 - The written recommendation of at least one member. E-mail and signed hard copy.
 - Membership fee of 100 EURO for the first year has directly to be paid after approval.

Processing of applications

- (1) The co-ordinator checks that the membership application is complete. If not, the applicant is informed of any deficiencies and asked to complete the application.
- (2) Once the application is deemed complete by the coordinator, the relevant document is forwarded to the membership committee together with a recommendation from the co-ordinator.
- (3) The membership committee takes decisions by means of meetings, teleconference or by correspondence. Ballots by correspondence can be carried out by mail, fax or e-mail. Approval of members shall be supported by at least two-thirds of the members of the committee.
- (4) If membership is denied, the reasons for this shall be clearly stated and communicated to the applicant.
