

## Tour 1, August 25; Picuris Pueblo

### Visit the small Pueblo (Native American tribal home and village) of Picuris.



Established around 1250 AD, it is the smallest of the Northern New Mexico Pueblos.

We will visit the **Inter Tribal Bison Program** and view the bison herd. Recently the pueblo restored its spiritual connection to the buffalo by maintaining a growing herd. We will also stop by the **Highland Food Gardens** that Seeds of Change is tending in partnership with the Picuris/Penasco Coalition.

The tour will take all day, lunch will be provided in the **tribally-owned restaurant**. Buses will leave at 9 AM, coming back at 6PM right in time to join the evening reception in the convention center.

- Guided tour to Highland Food Gardens Project

### Taste testing excursion to the Seeds of Change farm

Visit the Seeds of Change Farm and Gardens, near San Juan Pueblo (Ohkay Owingeh) to see some onsite organic agronomic research and variety development.



If you have sent seeds for trials, these can be viewed in the demonstration grounds and you can give a presentation on the varieties and work you are doing. We also will have a presentation and discussion on organic plant and animal breeding and have a **fresh produce tasting panel**. On the way back from the farm we will visit the Pueblo to experience some of the Native Indian culture. The tour will take half a day, buses will leave at 9.45 AM and will be back right in time for the closing ceremony. Lunch will be provided.
